Preference will be given to articles highlighting the results of scientific research conducted in cooperation with scientific organizations from the CIS countries.

Application instructions

Scientific topics of the conference

1. Study and conservation of plant diversity in culture and in nature.
2. Creation of national bioresource collections, including rare and endangered species.
3. Mobilization and introduction of wild flora forms.
4. Development of theoretical foundations and methodic recommendations for introduction in botanical gardens.
5. Plant diversity in connection with ecological and food security of regions in the context of global climate change and human impact.
6. Invasions of alien species: study of biological features and intraspecific variability of alien species, assessment of their invasive potential, development of measures to prevent plant invasions.
7. Fundamental principles of the study and rational use of plant resources.
8. Creation of educational and rehabilitation sphere in botanical gardens.

Annex 2. Submission guidelines

Materials of reports in Russian or English, up to 5 pages, designed in accordance with the rules, must be sent to the conference e-mail by **April 1, 2022**. (mbgconference@gmail.com, in the subject of the letter, specify the BOTANICAL GARDENS of the CIS).

Article file: it is prepared using the MS Office Word text editor. The article is issued as a separate file. The file should be named by the author's surname and the first words of the title of the article, for example, Petrov I.S. Biology of flowering.doc.

Margins: 20mm each

Article title: contains the title of the report (**TIMES NEW ROMAN SIZE 14, BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**, center alignment), full name of the participant(s). On the next line, the e-mail of the author(s) in italics, center alignment, on the next line - the name of the organization(s), city, country - in italics, TNR, 12 size, center alignment.

Abstract of the article - at least 40 words, contains brief information about the relevance of the problem, the purpose of the study, methods and results obtained (font - Times New Roman 12pt. Word **Abstract** – bold).

Keywords - no more than 7 words or phrases (font - Times New Roman 12pt. Word **Keyword** – bold). Separate them from words in English by one interval.

The title of the article, information about the authors, abstract and keywords should be written **in English** in the same format, separated from the text of the article by one interval. If the article is presented in English, it is necessary to provide its title, information about the authors, an abstract and keywords in Russian.

Credits (*links to grants, projects - if available*) (TNR, 12 size, paragraph indentation 1.25 cm) are given at the end of the article before the references list.

Font and paragraph level: Times New Roman 14 points, line spacing for the text of the article – "one and a half"; for the title, information about the authors, abstract, keywords, list of references - "single", paragraph indentation - 1.25 cm, interval: before - 0, after - 0. Width alignment. The text of the article is separated from the keywords by one interval.

Figures: figures prepared in the format .jpg or .bmp, must be duplicated by separate files. The size of the drawing should not exceed 80x100 mm. The drawings must be numbered and have captions. The word "Fig." is highlighted in bold. The graphic file should be named by the author's last name and the word Fig.

References: given at the end of the article and compiled in the order of mentioning sources in accordance with State Standard GOST 7.0.100-2018. The references list is separated from the text of the article by one interval. Binding of the text to bibliographic sources (link) is mandatory and is made out in the text of the materials in square brackets with an ordinal number. It is not recommended to use automatic numbering in the references list.
